# MilagrosCare

## What is it?

MilagrosCare is a full-day Montessori based program that runs from **8:00am to 6:00pm from Monday to Friday**. This means that all our activities are conducted by Montessori-trained teachers, with lower student to teacher ratio compared to regular childcares.

## Is it a child care program?

No. Unlike childcare programs that aim to take care of children in the absence of parents, MilagrosCare is a full-day Montessori program which incorporates developmentally appropriate activities that are intellectually interesting to the child. **We replace their after-school TV time at home with activities** that enable them to apply the theories they have learnt during Kindergarten program in a tangible hands-on way.



## Who is it for?

This program is for N2, K1, and K2 students (4 to 6 years). At Milagros, we refer to our N2, K1, and K2 students as CASA 1, CASA 2, and CASA 3.



## Will it run during holidays?

Yes. The program will run throughout the year except for 1 week in June and 2 weeks in December.

## How about June/Dec Holiday Program?

MilagrosCare students will receive complimentary enrolment into our June and December Holiday Programs. That means they will be able to attend holiday program without any extra payment.

# Activities



## Outdoor Play

Children feel most invigorated when they move around and play outdoors. A big part of Montessori education is exposing the child to an outdoor setting outside of the classroom. Students will get ample opportunities to move around and engage in fun outdoor activities while being supervised by our teachers.



## Public Speaking

Being able to stand in front of a crowd and speak confidently is becoming an increasingly valuable skill today. Students will be given ample opportunities to hone this skill through our Speech & Drama time, where they will practice expressing themselves in a confident and eloquent manner.



## Culinary Arts

Preparing food is not just a fun activity for children, but also an incredibly sensorial one! It combines touch with taste and a keen appreciation for food. We educate them on the origins of food from various cultures, and allow them practice handling food in a hygienic and respectful manner.

# Activities

## Character Building & Problem Solving

When a child is faced with a problem, they run to an adult. What if, instead of running to an adult, they could hone their problem-solving skill to find a solution? What if the child could think logically and reach to a conclusion all by themselves? What if the child becomes familiar with conflict resolution? ## Music & Art

Music is essential in training and refining a child's auditory senses, and Art is one of the most loved subjects by our students. Our Music & Art curriculum introduces Montessori bells to enhance musical ability as well as the 7 elements of art to hone artistic skills.

Our outdoor Gardening program is anchored in the Montessori philosophy that stresses the importance of connecting with nature in a deeply therapeutic way. Through gardening, we teach students how to not only appreciate and love nature, but more importantly nurture it.
