Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What is it?

MilagrosCare is a full-day Montessori based program that runs from 8 am to 6 pm from Monday to Friday. This means that all our activities are conducted by Montessori-trained teachers, with lower student to teacher ratio compared to regular day cares.



Is it a childcare program?

No. Unlike childcare programs that aim to take care of children in the absence of parents, MilagrosCare is a full-day Montessori program which incorporates developmentally appropriate activities that are intellectually interesting to the child. **We replace their after-school TV time at home with activities** that enable them to apply the theories they have learnt during Kindergarten program in a tangible hands-on way.



Who is it for?

This program is for N2, K1, and K2 students (4 to 6 years). At Milagros, we refer to our N2, K1, and K2 students as CASA 1, CASA 2, and CASA 3.



Will food be provided? My child is vegetarian and/or has allergies.

Morning snack time and lunch will NOT be provided. **Afternoon snacks will be provided.** Don't worry, all food allergies will be noted down prior to enrolling into the program!

Will there be nap time?

For children who require nap time, may do so after lunch. Children who are not taking naps will partake in quiet activities. Our nap mattresses will not be communally available to all students for hygiene purposes. Hence, those opting for nap time will need make a one-time payment of \$50 for a mattress that will belong to just them. Parents are expected to bring a blanket & sheet to school every Monday, that will be returned at the end of each week. The child may bring 1 favourite soft toy and a pillow if they'd like. If they require milk, parents may pack dry milk powder in a bottle to school. We will prepare the milk for them.



I end work late. Can I pick up my child later than 6pm?

As our centre has to close on time, we unfortunately cannot accommodate pick-ups beyond 6pm. We allow a 10-minute grace period, after which a late pick-up fee of \$25 will be charged if the parent/guardian arrives between 6:10pm and 6:30pm. In the event that the parent/guardian arrives any time beyond 6:30pm, a fine of \$50 will be imposed. All fees and fines pertaining to late pick-ups will be invoiced separately.



I took a half day to spend some time with my child. Can I pick them up earlier?

Of course! You may pick up your child at any time after the Kindergarten program ends at 12:30pm.



Does this program run through holidays?

Yes. The program will run throughout the year except 1 week in June and 2 weeks in December.



How about the June and December Holiday Program?

MilagrosCare students will receive complimentary enrolment into our June and December Holiday Programs. That means they will attend holiday program without any extra payment.



Can I use CDA for the payment?

A part of the program fee can be paid using CDA. Please contact the office for details.
